TIPS FOR UNDOCUMENTED WORKERS INJURED WHILE WORKING

- Do not provide a social security number that you know is false for **ANYTHING** related to your workers' compensation claim. This includes signing any documents with the false number typed on the form.
- There is no requirement under the workers' compensation law to provide a social security number, state identification card (e.g. driver's license), or a social security card in order to apply for or receive benefits.
- The insurance adjuster and/or case manager for the insurance company are employees of the insurance company. While they may help sometimes, their job is to help the insurance company over helping the injured worker.
- **KNOW YOUR RIGHTS.** If you are being told you have to provide certain information or documents that you know is false, consult with an attorney regarding your rights and obligations under the law.
